Salvatore Meli, born in 1953 graduated in Chemistry Engineering at the University of Naples. Researcher at the Industrial Chemistry Institute and Chemical Plants of the same Faculty from 1978 to 1980 in the field of research on Security for Chemical Plants.

Subsequently in 1992 he has been introduced as researcher in an Eni research project on the development of fuels and lubricants.

From 1994 to 1998 he coordinated process and experimental activities that contributed in a significant way to the enhancement of remote energetic resources (liquids from gas through Fisher – Tropsch synthesis) for mud treatment and soils polluted by hydrocarbons.

In 1988 endorses the role of Specialized Group Coordinator “Engineering Research” of Eni Researches where he contributed significantly in many fields.

From the 1st of January 2008, he has the role of Technology Responsible in the Strategy and Development Unit of Eni Corporate which prefigures the role of planning, management and control of R&D activities on strategy themes of Corporate interest, as well as addresses and coordinates the research activities of the various Divisions.

And lately there has been a very innovative element represented by the introduction of the TECNOL Unite of the Donegani Research Center, with the aim of enforcement and direction towards non conventional energies research themes. At the same time, to the management is entrusted the responsibility to “internationalize” Eni Research, starting with a substantial collaboration with MIT (USA).
