The below principles are followed:

- focus on persons, sharing experience and knowledge, encouraging participation and giving value to professionalism and behaviours
- cooperation between all resources and active contribution by all employees and contractors
- focus on the different stakeholders, on their expectation in order to give value to the community with an efficient communication
- support to the business initiative in order to transform prospect in opportunity

These principles are realized with the following commitments:

- Compliance with the Eni Policy, the “HSE” and HR management models, the “Internal audit and risk management system”, the 231 HSE and Code of Ethic control standards;
- Dissemination of common ethic and professional values for consolidating a shared *corporate identity*;
- Development of rules in compliance with legal obligation and *best practice*;
- Adoption of a Management System in compliance with international standards and laws, which allows activities to be carried in responsibly way and improves the health and safety of employees, the respect for the environment, the energy efficiency and the prompt response to any emergency;
- Continues improvement of the Management System and of the HSE services in order to reduce incidents, accidents, occupational disease, environmental impact and to maintain biodiversity;
- Adoption of the best international practices related to HSE and to the natural resources use;
- Provide for human, economic and technical resources adequate to meet the yearly and 4 yearly plan objectives;
- Develop HSE, environmental, energy efficiency and circular economy awareness and engagement so that the entire staff provide their contribution in a responsible way;
- Protection of workers' health through the tight integration between the identification, assessment and mitigation of specific risks related to the job, monitoring and improvement of environmental conditions in the workplace and health surveillance programs;
- Identify through the risk analyses the possible health, safety and environment emergency scenarios, define the emergency plan in line with health, safety, environment and public safety best practices;
- Analysis, in their dynamics, of any accidents / injuries, near misses or emergency situations, with a view to continuous improvement of prevention and protection and dissemination of lesson learned;
- Promotion of Employees consultation and participation to the risk and opportunity evaluation as part of the continuous improvement process;
- Periodic information to employees, Trade Unions, Top Management, Watch Structure (Organismo di Vigilanza), regarding the objectives and results achieved;
- Collaboration, when required, with the Authorities for the definition of standard, guideline related to Health, Safety, Environment, Energy;
- Promotion of the Quality culture as way to be and to operate, as important influential tool and invaluable element for a sustainable development;
- Continuous review of the above principles and periodic checks on their application.
