

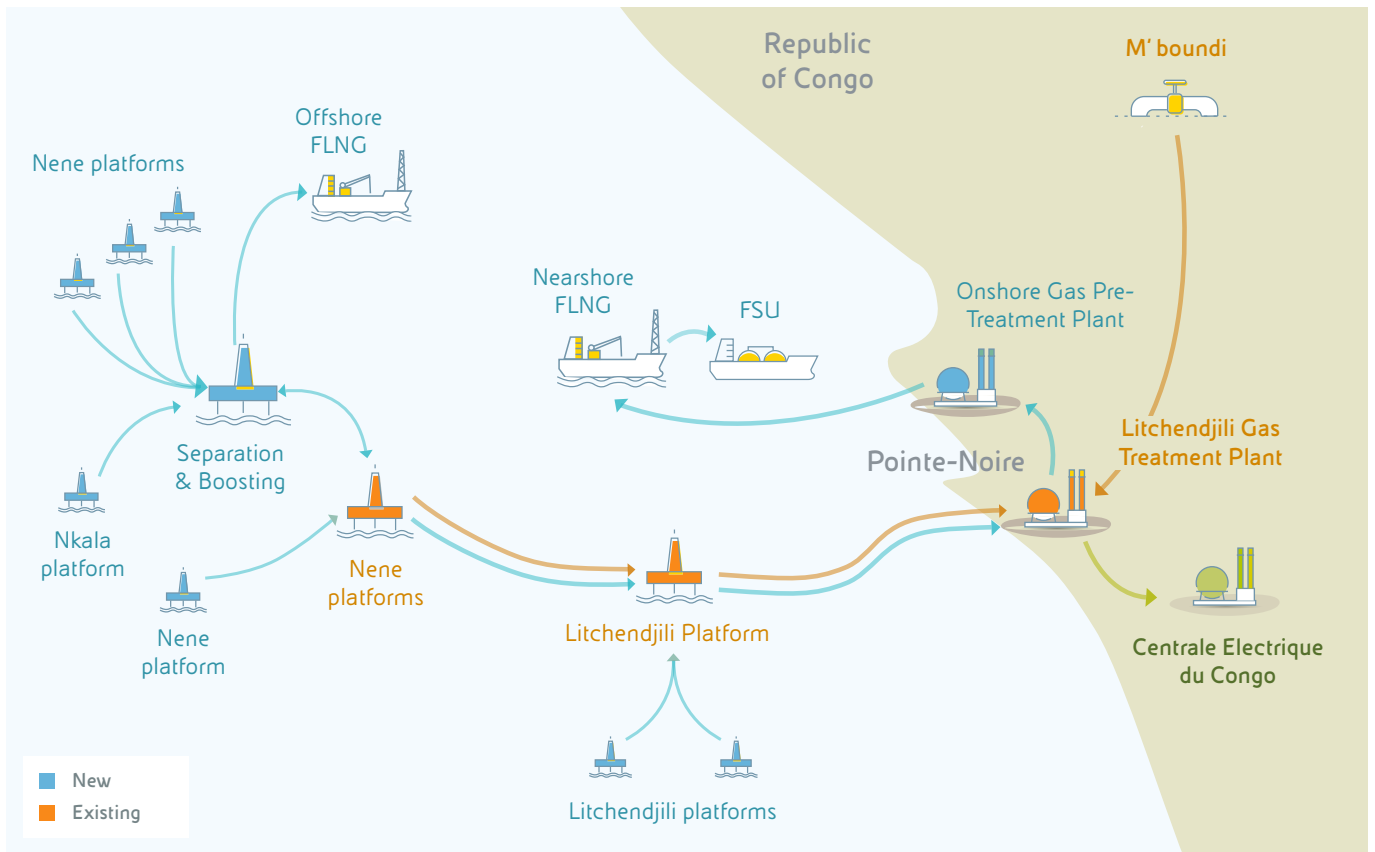
Congo LNG: taking Congo's gas to global markets

Congo LNG is Eni's new development project that will enhance the value of Congo's considerable gas reserves.

In addition to contributing to fulfil domestic energy needs, Congo LNG will be the first project exporting LNG from Congo, providing additional gas resources to the global market.

The project will leverage Marine XII gas resources and existing production facilities in a new phased approach. Production from two FLNGs will start respectively in 2023 and in 2025, with LNG export volumes of 3MTPA at plateau and achievement of the zero routine gas flaring objective.

In order to achieve **production start-up in 2023**, a fast-track development has been implemented. The project envisages the conversion of an existing FLNG unit with a **capacity 0.6 Mtpa** which will be installed 3 km offshore the new gas pre-treatment plant, located near the existing Litchendjili facilities. Along with the FLNG a Floating Storage Unit will be installed. This will enable early valorization of existing gas capacity ahead of the Offshore FLNG start-up.

A second FLNG with a **capacity of 2.4 Mtpa** will start-up in 2025. Construction of this facility has begun in Wison shipyard in China and is expected to be completed in 2025. Once both facilities will be operational, the overall **liquefaction capacity of Marine XII will be 3 MTPA**.

Sustainability

Sustainability initiatives focusing on access to education, health, water and agriculture will be deployed in rural areas for local communities. A special focus will be granted to initiatives to enhance educational offer boosting educational capacity for nearly 10,000 high school students and teachers.
