



The Chairman of Libya's National Oil Corporation, Mustafa Sanalla, meets Eni's CEO, Claudio Descalzi

Rome (Italy), 22 December 2015 - The Chairman of the Libyan National Oil Corporation (NOC), Mustafa Sanalla met Eni's CEO, Claudio Descalzi in Rome.

The meeting focused on the outlook for development of the oil sector in Libya. It was an opportunity to further enhance the excellent relations developed between the two companies, who are linked by a historic partnership that makes Eni the largest foreign producer of hydrocarbons in all regions of Libya.
