Subject: Annual GHG emissions report for Coral South

CORAL FLNG S.A. (hereinafter referred to as "CORAL"), a Special Purpose Entity, incorporated and regulated under Mozambican Laws, is committed to operating responsibly and in a transparent manner related to GHG accounting and reporting in alignment with the requirements of OGMP 2.0¹ and other applicable standards, including the Equator Principles, the OECD Common Approaches and the IFC EHS Performance Standards.

As part of CORAL Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Management Framework, intended to minimize GHG emissions, CORAL, as Operator of the Coral Sul FLNG facility, hereby provides the annual disclosure of GHG emissions and GHG intensity for the operational phase of the Coral South² for the reporting year 2025.

GHG emissions reported herein include Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions, being Scope 1 defined as direct emissions from Coral South operations while Scope 2 emissions are defined as indirect emissions associated with the off-site production of energy used by Coral South. All emissions are quantified and reported in accordance with the GHG Protocol.

For the year 2025, Coral South recorded total GHG emissions of 1,052,055 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent, comprising of combined Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions, corresponding to a production-based GHG intensity³ of 27.8 kilogrammes of carbon dioxide equivalent per barrel of oil equivalent.
