## Policy on Health, Safety, Environment and Public Safety of LNG Shipping SpA

LNG shipping, in accordance with the principles expressed in the Policy of eni spa and in line with the HSE objectives set by the relevant BU, intends to pursue in all its offices the sustainable development of its activities of navigation and maritime transport for the transport of liquefied natural gas through the use of a fleet of owned tankers, devoting the utmost commitment to the continuous improvement of its performance in the field of health and safety of the process and in the workplace, and protecting the environment, with the aim of preventing injuries, accidents, ensuring the health and safety of its employees, the integrity of its vessels and the protection of the environment.

The HSE Policy of Ing shipping is a document issued by Senior Management that translates and applies the Policies of eni spa to Ing shipping.

The HSE Policy is appropriate to the nature and size of lng shipping, as well as the environmental impacts, and the risks to health and safety related to its activities and services. The HSE Policy defines and documents the overall commitment of lng shipping:

- > to comply with all laws and regulations as well as with any other applicable subscribed requirement;
- > to the continuous improvement of HSE performance;
- > to the prevention of pollution, injuries and occupational diseases.

## Through

- ➤ the management of industrial and commercial activities in full compliance with national and international laws and in accordance with the policies and procedures in place in the business sector
- > the adoption of the principles, standards and solutions that constitute international business best practices for the protection of health, safety, the environment and public safety
- ➤ the design, location, construction, operation and decommissioning of any activity or plant with respect for the environment, for the safety and protection of the health and safety of the employees and third parties, based on prevention
- the promotion of research and technological innovation for the development of advanced environmental protection, protection and enhancement of biodiversity and energy efficiency, protection of the health and safety of workers and communities
- ➤ the involvement of the entire UO lng shipping spa and of all of its employees, suppliers and contractors in the management of aspects of health, safety and the environment and in achieving the improvement objectives
- the training of personnel and the exchange of experiences and knowledge, considered fundamental tools for achieving the objectives related to health, safety, the environment and public safety, with a view to continuous improvement

- ➤ employee participation, as part of their duties, in the process of safeguarding and protecting health, safety and the environment, towards themselves, their colleagues and the public
- periodic information to employees, trade unions, authorities and the public about the programmes and the achieved results
- > collaboration with the authorities at local, national and international levels, and with Agencies and Associations in the development of standards and guidelines and the promotion of scientific and technological developments aimed at improving health, safety and the environment
- > verification of the management of aspects of health, safety and the environment by way of control systems, continuous revision of the principles listed above with the aim of continuous improvement and acquisition of information flows for the monitoring of their implementation
- > actions to prevent loss of life and damage to natural persons and to protect company assets through the constant monitoring of safety, technical and operational efficiency and the security measures for ships
- > raising the awareness of all personnel regarding security, continuously improving the technical and operational efficiency of sea and land personnel
- > compliance with applicable regulations to protect the environment, especially the marine environment
