Biography

After a PhD at the Ecole Normale Supérieure, Paris (1984), a post-doctoral fellowship at the Karolinska Institute, Stockholm, Sweden (1985-1986), and 20 years as Professor of Chemistry at the University Joseph Fourier, Grenoble (1988-2008), Marc Fontecave is now Professor at the Collège de France, Paris, since 2009, holding the Chair of Chemistry of Biological Processes. He is the director of the Laboratory of Chemistry of Biological Processes (research unit CNRS/Collège de France/Sorbonne University). He is a member of the French Science Academy since 2005, where he is chairing the Energy Committee since 2019, a member of Academia Europaea since 2010 and a member of the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences since 2019.
