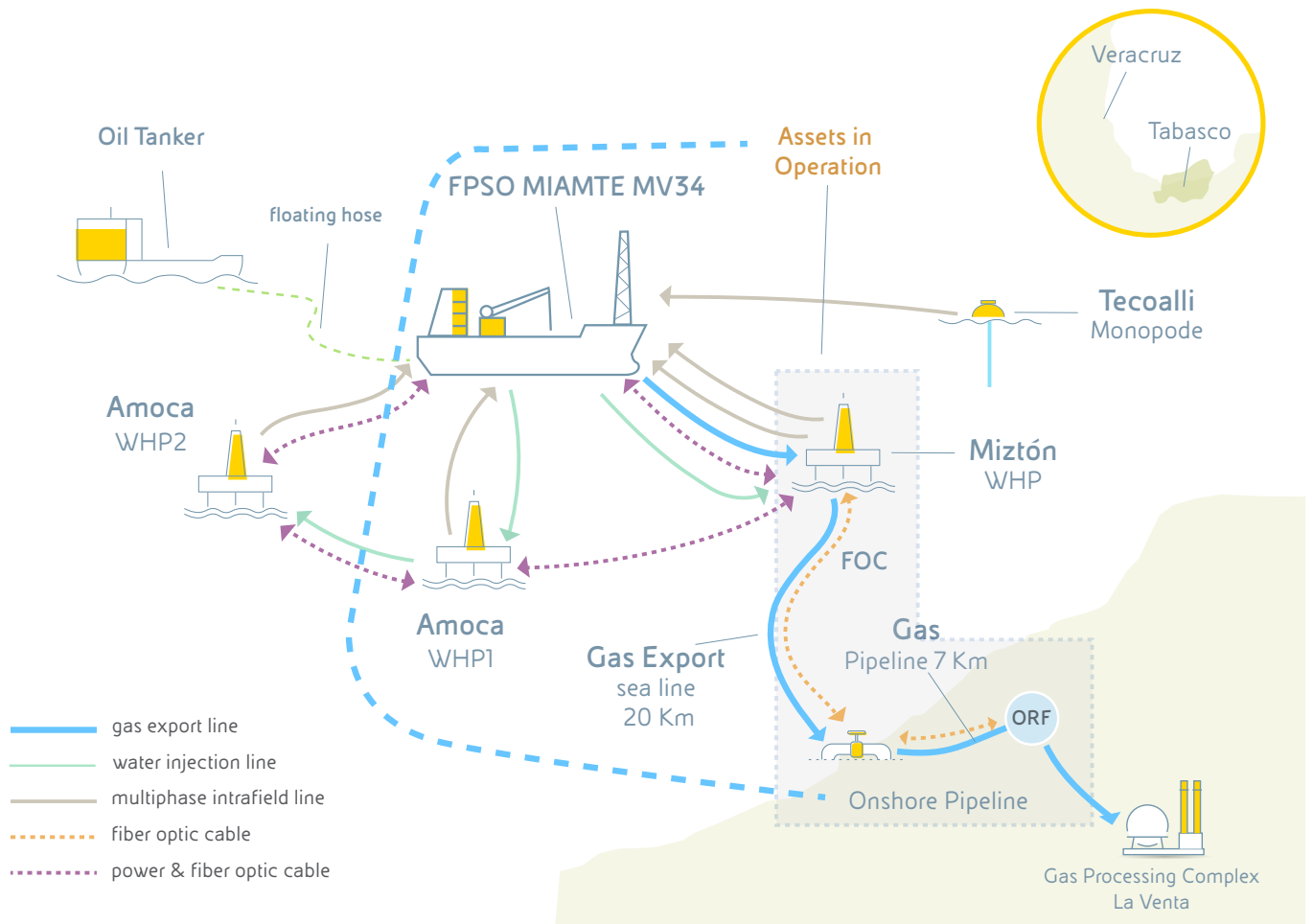

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**Sáasken**

In February 2020, Eni made a new oil discovery on the **Sáasken** Exploration Prospect in **Block 10**. It is located about 65 kilometers off the coast, in a water depth of 340 meters. The discovery was appraised by a second well drilled by Eni Mexico in 2021, confirming the volumetric estimation in the range of **200 million barrels of oil in place**. Upside potential is present nearby.

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**Sayulita**

In August 2021, Eni made an additional oil discovery in **Block 10** on the **Sayulita** Exploration Prospect, located just 15 km away from the previous oil discovery. Data analysis indicates that the new find may contain between **150 and 200 million barrels of oil in place**. Evaluations are ongoing to identify synergic development opportunities in the area.

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**Yatzil**

In March 2023, Eni made a new oil discovery on the **Yatzil** Exploration Prospect in **Block 7**. It represents Eni's eighth successful well drilled in the basin. The discovery is located 25 to 30 kilometers away from other discoveries. According to preliminary estimates, the discovery may hold **more than 200 million barrels of oil in place**.

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**Saasil**

In May 2024, Eni made a new oil discovery on the **Saasil-1** Exploration Prospect in **Block 10**. It is located approximately 65 kilometers off the coast, in the mid-deep water of the Cuenca Salina in the Sureste Basin, offshore Mexico. The new finding may contain around **250-300 million barrels of oil in place**.

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**Yoopat**

In July 2024, Eni made a new oil discovery on the **Yoopat-1** Exploration Prospect in **Block 9**. It represents Eni's ninth successful well drilled in the basin. The discovery is located approximately 63 kilometers off the coast, in the mid-deep water of the Cuenca Salina in the Sureste Basin, offshore Mexico. The preliminary estimates indicate a discovered potential of around **300-400 million barrels equivalents of oil and associated gas in place**.

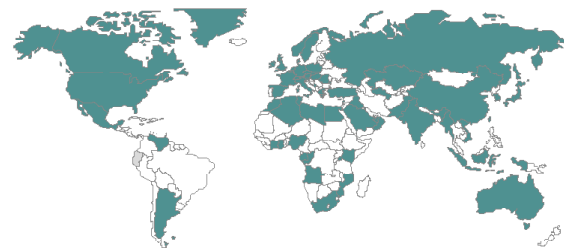
