



Eni CEO Paolo Scaroni met with Iraqi Prime Minister Nuri Al-Maliki

San Donato Milanese (Milan), 3 December 2012 – Iraqi Prime Minister Nuri Al-Maliki and Eni's CEO Paolo Scaroni met today in Baghdad to discuss Eni's activities in the Country.

During the meeting, which was cordial, Eni's CEO updated the Prime Minister on the development activities of Zubair's super giant field and confirmed Eni's commitment and presence in the Country. The parties also discussed the state of development of the Iraqi hydrocarbon sector, its potential and opportunities that could be jointly developed. The Prime Minister al-Maliki expressed his satisfaction with the activities carried out by Eni in the Country.
