

The President of Cyprus Nicos Anastasiades meets Eni's CEO, Claudio

Descalzi briefed President Anastasiades on the latest developments of hydrocarbon

Cyprus and the eastern Mediterranean and will continue to work with the Government of the

Republic of Cyprus to develop the Country's energy potential.

Among the topics discussed during the meeting were the evolution of the energy and

geopolitical scenarios that the gas discovery made off Egypt will bring throughout the area

and the role that Cyprus, due to its energy potential, will play in the near future.

Eni believes in the significant synergies of joint development in the entire area of the eastern

Mediterranean. This area could be of crucial strategic importance as a gas hub for the whole

region and also makes an important contribution to European energy security.
