

Privacy Information Notice

(art. 13 EU Regulation no. 2016/679)

Students' personal data provided by the application through the above mentioned modalities will be processed by Eni Corporate University, as data controller, in compliance with the applicable law on the protection of personal data and, in particular, the EU Regulation no. 2016/679.

In particular, the students' data will be processed for the purpose of evaluating the application for Eni's scholarships, as described in this call for applications. Failure to provide data or subsequent opposition to the data processing necessary for the purpose of application - occurred before the end of the same - will determine the impossibility to participate and thus to obtain Eni's scholarships. The data may also be processed for the purposes of compliance with legal provisions, both in civil and fiscal matters, regulations and European legislation, as well as rules, codes or procedures approved by the authorities and other competent institutions.

The data will be kept for the time not exceeding that necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed, in accordance with applicable provisions and will not be disclosed.

The data may be communicated in Italy only to those subjects directly involved in the fulfilment of the mandatory requirements provided for in this call for applications, as well as to delegated subjects.

In accordance with applicable data protection provisions, data subjects have the following rights with respect to their personal data: (i) the right of access, in particular by requesting, at any time, confirmation of the existence of personal data in the Data Controllers' databases and the provision of such information in a clear and intelligible manner; (ii) the right to know the origin, logic and purpose of the processing with express and specific indication of the persons in charge and responsible for processing and third parties to whom the data may be disclosed; (iii) the right to obtain the updating and rectification of data (except for evaluative data), the cancellation of superfluous data or its transformation into anonymous form, as well as the blocking of processing and final cancellation in the event of unlawful processing; and (iv) if the conditions are met, the limitation of processing and portability of data. The law also recognizes the possibility of lodging a complaint with the Data Protection Authority, if the data subject recognizes a violation of his/her rights under the current legislation on data protection.

In any case, the Data Controller has the right to oppose the exercise of the rights of the data subject in the cases provided for by law, for example in the event of the use or storage of the data for exercising or defending a legal claim, limited to the period during which effective and concrete damage could be caused.
