Biography

Robert Schlögl studied chemistry and completed his PhD at Ludwig Maximilian University in Munich. After post-doctoral stays at Cambridge and Basle and a professorship at University Frankfurt, in 1994 he was appointed director at Fritz Haber Institute of the Max Planck Society in Berlin and in 2011 - in addition - he became founding director of the Max Planck Institute for Chemical Energy Conversion in Mülheim a.d. Ruhr.

He is an Honorary Professor at Technical University Berlin, at Humboldt University Berlin and at University Duisburg-Essen, Ruhr University Bochum and a Distinguished Affiliate Professor at TU Munich.

Robert Schlögl's research mainly focuses on inorganic chemistry, heterogeneous catalysis, nanostructures, material science for chemical energy conversion and concepts for sustainable energy supply and storage.
